While addressing the National Editor's Conference on March 23, 2013 **Shri K. State/UT Waqf Boards, where substantial Pre-Digitization Work is completed then actual Digitization Work is also started simultaneously, i.e., all the Ownership rights establishing Documents are Scanned, Indexed using WAMSI-BDU Utility and batch-wise imported into WAMSI-DMS Software at the respective SWB premises for searching and retrievals as and when required in digital formats.
